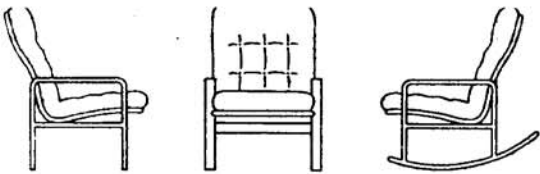

Chair & Rocker

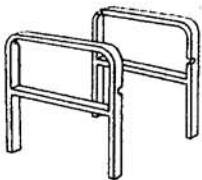
Dear Customer:

(Left & Right)

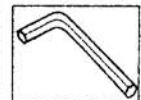


Wood Stretchers (2)

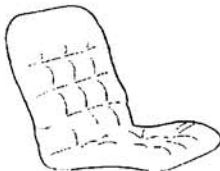

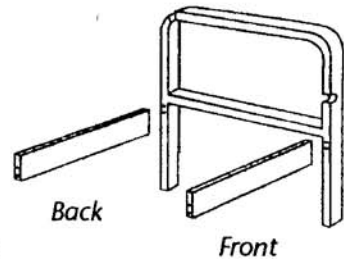

STEP 1

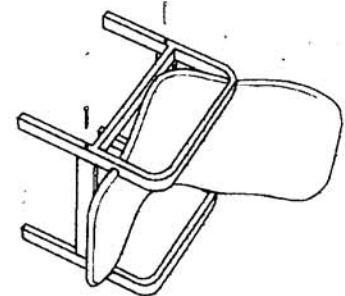
Attach both stretchers to one of the pair of wooden arms using the bolts and hex wrench provided. The stretcher plugs fit snugly into the inside lower holes.



Note: If one stretcher is marked Front, make sure to attach it at the front arm position, i.e. where the groove is lowest.

STEP 2

Place assembly on a padded floor with stretchers pointing up. Insert covered seat frame into grooves of wooden arms. Be sure that zipper of cover is underneath and in front.



Place second wooden arm over seat frame and fasten firmly with bolts.

STEP 3

Turn chair upright. Place seat cushion onto seat, with tag at top. For highback models, place head cushion over top of seat cushion, letting wooden counterweight dangle behind. If desired, open LumBar access zipper and adjust LumBar height for optimal lower back support.



Retightening of bolts:

The bolts may become loose as changes in humidity cause wood to shrink. Keep the hex wrench in the holder behind the front stretcher should retightening become necessary.
